


2018 Garrison Mixed Double Rules

- A team is composed of two players, no gender restrictions. Alternate players are **not** allowed. A team must forfeit any game(s) in which it fails to have both athletes playing for the entire game.
- The scoring shall be the same as in a regular game of curling. The “positioned” stones that are placed before the beginning of each end are eligible to be counted in the scoring.
- Each game will be scheduled for **(6) ends. There will be no buzzer. Please play an extra end if there is a tie.**
- Each team shall deliver five (5) stones per end. The player delivering the team’s first stone of the end must also deliver the team’s last stone of that end. The other team member shall deliver the team’s second, third and fourth stones for that end. The player delivering the first stone can change from end to end.
- **Modified FGZ** – No stone in play, including the “positioned” stones and those in the house, can be moved to an out-of-play position prior to the delivery of the fourth stone of an end (the fourth delivered stone is the first stone that can remove any stone from play). If there is a violation, the delivered stone shall be removed from play, and any displaced stone(s) shall be replaced to their original position by the non-offending team
- **Position of stationary stones** – Prior to the start of every end, the team with the choice (or hammer) shall place their team’s stationary stone, and their opponent’s stationary stone, in either position “A” or “B”
- A – a stone bisecting the centre line, midway between the hog line and the front of the house
- **Position B:** Placement so that the stone is bisected by the centre line and is in the **back of the 4-foot circle**. The back edge of the stone is aligned with the back edge of the 4-foot circle.
- If they choose to place their stone ‘out front’, they shall deliver first stones in the end. Therefore, should they choose to be behind the button, they shall have last stone in the end. The team not scoring in the previous end, shall have the ‘choice’ in the next end. If the end is blanked, the choice shall change to the team that delivered first in the blanked end.

Power Play Option. This option can be used by each team once in a 6 end game when they have the decision on the placement of the “positioned” stones – but never in an extra end.

The in-house stone (B), which belongs to the team with last stone in that end, is placed with the back edge of the stone abutting the front edge the tee line, with half the stone in the 8-foot and half in the 12-foot circle.

The guard stone is positioned to the side of the sheet, so the centre of the stone would be bisected by the inside edge of the stone in play.

The distance of this corner guard from the house will be the same distance that was determined for the centre guards.

The Power Play can be chosen to be set up on either the left or the right side, depending on the team’s preference.
