

Submitting an insurance claim through Curling Alberta for on-ice injuries

One of the benefits of the Curling Alberta individual curler membership is access to insurance for certain on-ice injuries. [Click on this link](#) to be taken to the relevant Curling Alberta information, and then scroll down to “Insurance Coverage & Questions”. If the link is broken, [contact Curling Alberta](#) to obtain information.

Some injuries are minor and require nothing more than administering an ice pack; others can be more serious and may require the attendance of emergency services. In some cases, what had earlier been thought to be less serious may escalate - and that might not be known for days, weeks or even months.

Depending on the nature and severity of the injury and/or the member’s out-of-pocket expenses in dealing with it, an insurance claim through Curling Alberta may or may not ultimately be submitted.

In order to clarify responsibility for preparing and filing documents in support of a possible insurance claim through Curling Alberta, the GCC has adopted the following protocols:

1. Curlers (who have paid the Curling Alberta fee) who have sustained an injury on the ice and wish to make an insurance claim through Curling Alberta are required to fill out the form set out as Schedule “A” (the “Accident Report”). The GCC will not fill out the Accident Report on behalf of the curler. The Accident Report is *in addition* to any internal report the GCC creates. The GCC is not obligated to remind a curler of the availability of the insurance or that an Accident Report can be filed.
2. Please send the Accident Report to the GCC by email at info@garrisoncurling.com. As currently required by Curling Alberta, the GCC submits the Accident Report to the insurer, which it is doing as a courtesy only to the curler. By submitting the Accident Report, the GCC is neither denying nor agreeing with the contents of the Accident Report.
